Meeting Summary

1. Welcome

• The chair welcomed committee members to the third quarterly meeting of the committee in 2023, and the last before the CAETS 2023 symposium in Zagreb, Croatia.

2. Minutes of previous quarterly meeting (9 March)

• The minutes of the 8 June meeting were accepted without amendment.

3. Review actions of the previous meeting

The committee noted all previous action items have been completed or are underway. ATSE will
continue developing a communications plan template for the 2024 round.

ACTION 1 – Secretariat supporting the committee will continue to work on a communication plan template for 2024.

4. CAETS2023 – communications committee matters

- The Committee heard that the CAETS Communications prize had a unanimously chosen winner to be announced at the CAETS Conference in Zagreb. The Chair noted the quality of submissions was excellent, and more numerous than the prior year.
 - The eventual winner Dr Caitlin Howell attended the conference in person to receive the prize and gave a good acceptance speech. The media release is on the <u>CAETS</u> Website.
 - Certificates of honourable mention were provided to Dr Marjolein Helder (Netherlands) and Professor Richard Hopkins (Australia).
- The Committee acknowledged the need to commence work on the communications prize in the near future due to the next CAETS symposium occurring in July 2024. The plan is for the 2024
 Prize recipient to attend the symposium, in addition to receiving a larger cash prize.

5. Committee Chair Reports to CAETS Board and Council meetings (at CAETS2023)

- The Committee accepted the presentation developed by the Chair for the annual CAETS board and council meetings. The presentation served as a report on committee activities and included a plan for 2024 which indicated proposed activities and needed resources.
- The Committee discussed respective Academy style guides for writing and noted structural challenges inhibiting a CAETS-wide writing framework.
- The Chair noted the importance of ensuring the Committee had representation from all CAETS academies.
- The Committee also discussed the need to secure a prospective deputy chair to succeed the departing incumbent.

- Prof. Wu Zhiqiang provided a presentation a on recent engagement project of the Chinese Academy
 of Engineering (CAE) aimed at increasing interest in urban planning and sustainability among
 students.
 - The presentation was similarly well received by the committee members, questions and discussions revolved around;
 - Th structure of CAE's communications & outreach office.
 - Overview and discussion of CAE's engagement of the general public high school students.
